Former Lakeview Resident to Embark on a 104-Mile Adventure

John Dietrick is a 76 year old who began running while in his 40's after a coworker told him he was "looking old". Currently, he refers to himself as "a trail hiker" and says walking by himself "is what I do".

Six years ago, John was struggling to cope with a traumatic life-changing event. His sister, Becky Fish, came from Indiana to stay with him to help and walk alongside John as he made the climb out of the darkness he found himself in. John survived, but he never forgot the love and sacrifice that his sister gave so generously.

Then about three vears ago. John took a couple of falls while on a sailboat. The first accident caused broken ribs and the second fall fractured his back. During treatment, it was discovered that he had heart problems. Quite unexpectedly. John ended up having open heart surgery. He recovered and eventually went back to his normal walking routine. He recalls a fellow walker once said to him, "As long as you can keep

walking, you'll be OK".

Still, he didn't forget how his sister cared for him. When John was dealing with heart problems, Becky was busy back in Madison County, Indiana establishing a

nonprofit organization called Papa's House, which is a home for women who have experienced life-changing situations and need help to recover, regroup and heal. This is what Becky does and is so good at. John says it's payback time

Earlier this year, John contacted Becky to let her know he wanted to use his hiking skills to raise awareness and financial support for Papa's House. He realized that this 501c(3) entity depends entirely on contributions from private individuals, businesses, churches, community foundations and sponsors.

On October John's Journey for Papa's House will begin east of Pictured Rocks and Grand Marais, Michigan as he covers the first few miles to position himself at the point on the North Country Trail where he will start his 100 mile hike of gratitude.
