## LHS Athlete Gets a Hole in One

On Tuesday September 2, Senior Molly Gray at Lakeview High School made the 94 yard shot of a lifetime on Hole #15 at Tullymore Golf Club capturing her first hole in one with her pitching wedge.

"I used my pitching wedge to get over the marshy area and watched my ball hit the front fringe. I knew it was on the green so I turned around and headed to my bag never thinking it was going in the hole. Coach Katrina was on the green and yelled back toward us, "who hit that?" My playing partners both yelled "Molly". I still didn't know what happened. While my coach was driving back to the tee box the other girls I was playing with were all excited and said "it went in the hole". I didn't realize how cool it was to get a hole in one until everyone kept congratulating me. I'm a quiet person and don't like to be in the spotlight, but even four days later I'm still having

people congratulate me", said Molly.

"I watched a young lady from Ithaca get a hole in one on Hole 4 at Tullymore 2 years ago which was really cool to witness for the first time but it's an entirely different feeling when one of your own players get a hole in one. Every time I mention it I get goosebumps. It was so amazing to see and I couldn't be more proud of Molly. She's a very humble young lady who doesn't like the spotlight", said Assistant Coach Katrina Corwin.

After contacting my husband, Brian Corwin, Head Coach of our program, I contacted Molly's dad, Brandon Gray. He got his hole in one his senior year on Hole 7, a 97 yard shot with his pitching wedge, in 2002 at The Fields in Ithaca. Brandon said "getting Coach Katrina's text about Molly was one of the greatest texts I have ever got.
