Lakeview Family Chiropractors Celebrates Forty Years

The photo from the Pioneer East shows a bearded young man holding a model of a spine and pelvis as one might hold a saxophone. Beside him stands a petite young woman with a radiant smile. With the opening of their Lakeview Family Chiropractors office at 228 Lincoln Avenue downtown, Dr. Gary and Dr. Cathleen Padden are embarking on an adventure that will knit them into the Lakeview community like well-adjusted vertebrae in

the spinal column. On Tuesday, January 27, they and their successors in the practice, Dr. Andy and Dr. Tiffany Padden, held an open house to celebrate forty years since the opening of that first office in Lakeview. Some of their original patients still come to them for spinal adjustments, as do their children and grandchildren.

Dr. Cathie and Dr. Gary met as students at Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic in Spartanburg, South Carolina. In those days before

the Internet, students in need of rides home for holidays and students with room in their cars for passengers (and room in their budgets for a bit of gas money) would post their information on a campus bulletin board dedicated to that purpose. As both hailed from the greater Detroit area, Dr. Gary from Wyandotte and Dr. Cathie from Dearborn Heights, they became acquainted on long shared rides north to Michigan and married while still students. Dr. Gary completed his degree

in 1983; Dr. Cathie followed in 1985.

While in Michigan on a school break, Dr. Cathie found an ad in their chiropractic magazine for a job opening that exactly fit her training and skills. She interviewed for the position with Dr. Joyce London in Greenville. The interview seemed to be going beautifully until Cathie mentioned that she was married. At that point, Dr. London seemed to freeze. That evening, however, she called Cathie to say, "I've found a job for your hus-

band." Reasoning that she would lose her promising new hire too quickly if her husband took a position elsewhere, she had made inquiries and found a suitable opening for Dr. Gary with a practice in Belding's Covered Village Mall. The two worked at those respective positions until opening Lakeview Family Chiropractors in 1986, encouraged by the Wales and Paris families among other early patients to establish their practice here.
