First Sergeant Mathew Newell Incoming First Sergeant



1SG Mathew L. Newell, a native of Lakeview, Michigan, is a distinguished Senior Licensed Practical Nurse and proven leader with over 17 years of dedicated service to the U. S. Army. He currently

serves as the First Sergeant for Alpha Company at Dwight D. Eisenhower Army Medical Center (DDEAMC), Fort Gordon, where he is responsible for the health, welfare, and professional development

of over 280 assigned Soldiers.

1SG Newell's career has been marked by exemplary leadership in a variety of critical operational and clinical environments. He was instrumental in

shaping Army Medicine as the Senior Training Developer for the 68C Licensed Practical Nurse program at the Medical Center of Excellence (MEDCoE), where he oversaw the 52-week training program for over 600 Soldiers annually across five national training sites. His operational assignments have proven his leadership in high-stakes roles; he served as the Task Force Med Chief Wardmaster for a Role 3 Hospital in Iraq, directing clinical operations for nearly 300 medical professionals and safeguarding over \$9.4 million in equipment and supplies. His other key assignments include serving as a Wardmaster and Platoon Sergeant for the 11th Field Hospital and as the Non-commissioned Officer in Charge of a 12-bed Intensive Care Unit at DDEAMC.

A graduate of every level of the Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development System, his military training also includes the Common Faculty Development-Developers Course and the Enlisted Subject Matter

Expert Course. Academically, 1SG Newell holds a Bachelor of Science in Health Care Administration from Purdue University Global and an Associate of Science from Kaplan University.

His personal awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC), Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Commendation Medal (3OLC), and Army Achievement Medal (8OLC). His proficiency as a soldier-medic is highlighted by his earning of the Combat Action Badge, the coveted Expert Field Medical Badge, and the Senior Army Instructor Badge. In 2024, for his significant and lasting contributions to the U.S. Army Medical Department, he was formally inducted into the prestigious Order of Military Medical Merit (O2M3).

He is married to Jaime Newell and has one daughter, Liberty.
