We celebrate that we have been here for our community for over 30 years! To have a full fitness center, with free weights, cardio equipment and a pool, in a small, little village like ours is amazing some folks can't believe it's here when they discover it.

A little more history: When Kelsey Hospital was sold to United Memorial Hospital, LCWC was let go and given back to the community with a debt of over \$700,000. As our own community non-profit, LCWC continued to lease

physical therapy space to Spectrum/Corewell Health until June 2024. This income helped LCWC pay down our debt. In June 2024 Corewell Health Physical Therapy moved to the new building on M-46.

At that time LCWC lost more than \$55,000 annual income.

Throughout its history, LCWC has remained committed to its mission: We are dedicated to a partnership in creating mental, emotional, physical and spiritual vitality. Vitality for life! We partner with local employers to bring fitness opportunities to employees and offer free

memberships to local fire fighters and police officers. We also offer deeply discounted memberships to some people unable to pay for regular memberships.

We are very grateful for annual grants from the Lakeview Area Community Foundation through the Bud and Anne Martin Fund and the Kenneth and Betsy Leppink Fund. These funds were set up for the benefit of LCWC and have helped LCWC make needed repairs and replace equipment over the years.

Without the generosity of these two funds LCWC may not be here today. The Meijer Founda-

tion has also been instrumental in helping LCWC begin and maintain our building. Many local businesses and families have contributed to our beginning and helped support LCWC through the years including the Bank of Lakeview, Tom Harkens, the Leppink Family in memory of Kent Leppink, the family of Kim and Sharyl Griffith and many, many others.

Last January we paid off our entire mortgage debt-thankfully!
